
All responses must be received by the consultation deadline of **11:59pm on 09 July 2026**. Following this consultation, we will consider all the feedback we receive and continue to refine our proposals ahead of submitting a Development Consent Order (DCO) application.

As part of this consultation, we are seeking your feedback on where different elements of South Brooks would be suitable, including areas for solar panels, as well as the potential location of battery storage and Project substation(s).





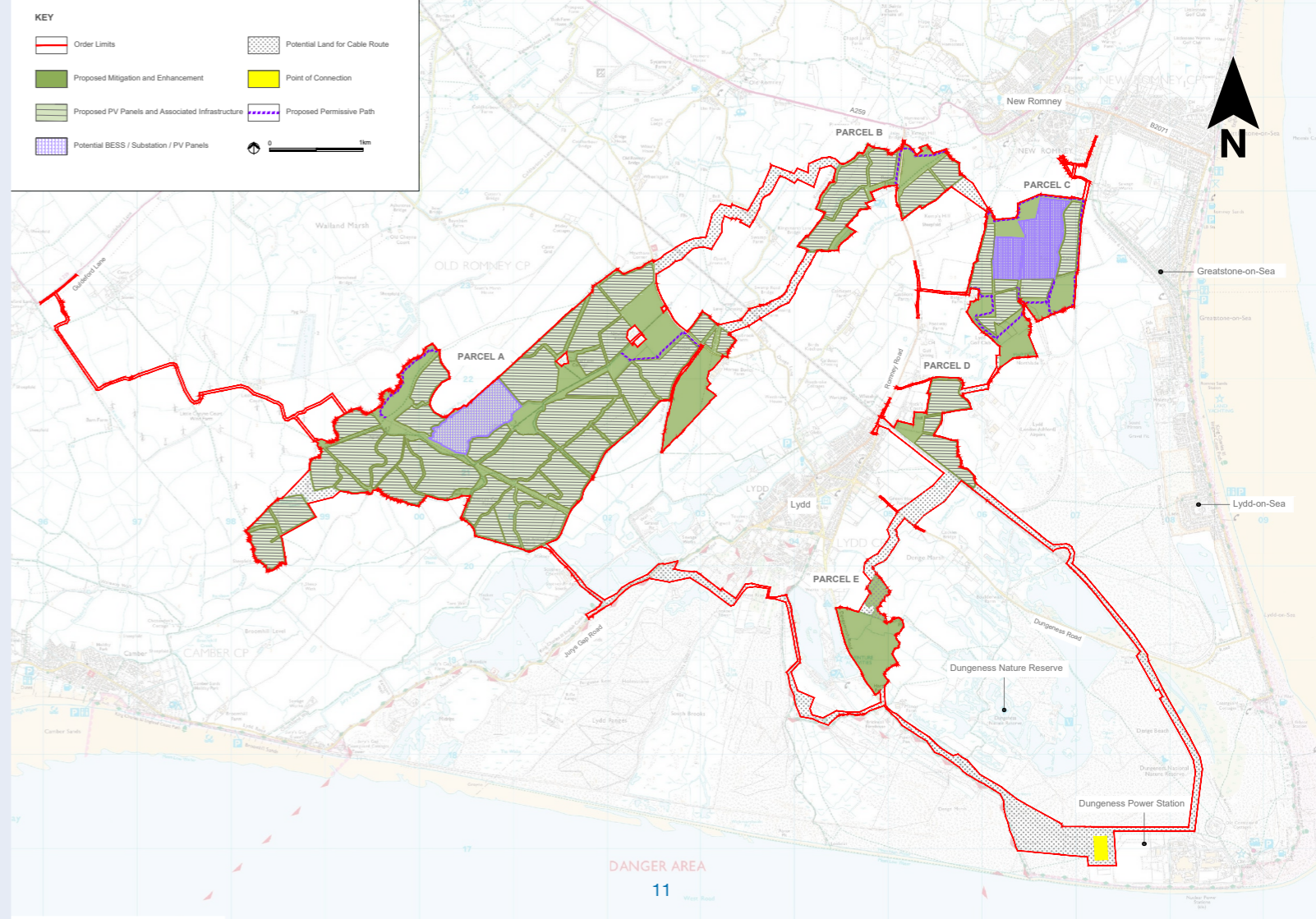
